


Hunted Heretic; The Life and Death of Michael Servetus, 1511-1553 (Beacon Series in Liberal Religion)



Selected as an outstanding religious book in the 1950s, this work gives a fascinating picture of a remarkable man, and one of the most remarkable religious mavericks of the sixteenth century. He was a polymath versed in many sciences: mathematics, astronomy and meteorology, geography, human anatomy, medicine and pharmacology, as well as jurisprudence, translation, poetry and the scholarly study of the Bible in its original languages. He is renowned in the history of several of these fields, particularly medicine and theology. He participated in the Protestant Reformation, and later developed a nontrinitarian Christology. Condemned by Catholics and Protestants alike, he was arrested in Geneva and burnt at the stake as a heretic by order of the city's Protestant governing council.
