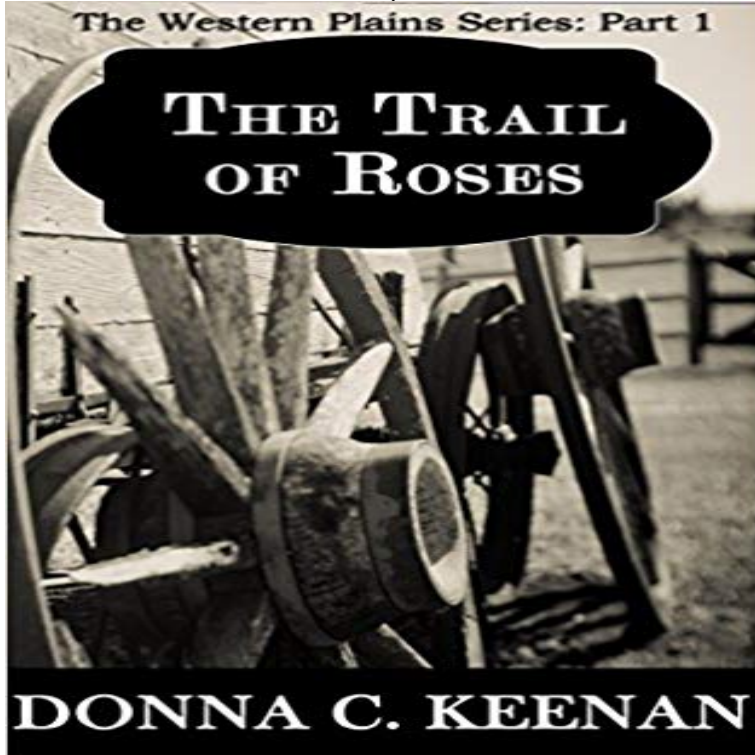


The Trail of Roses (The Western Plains Book 1)
