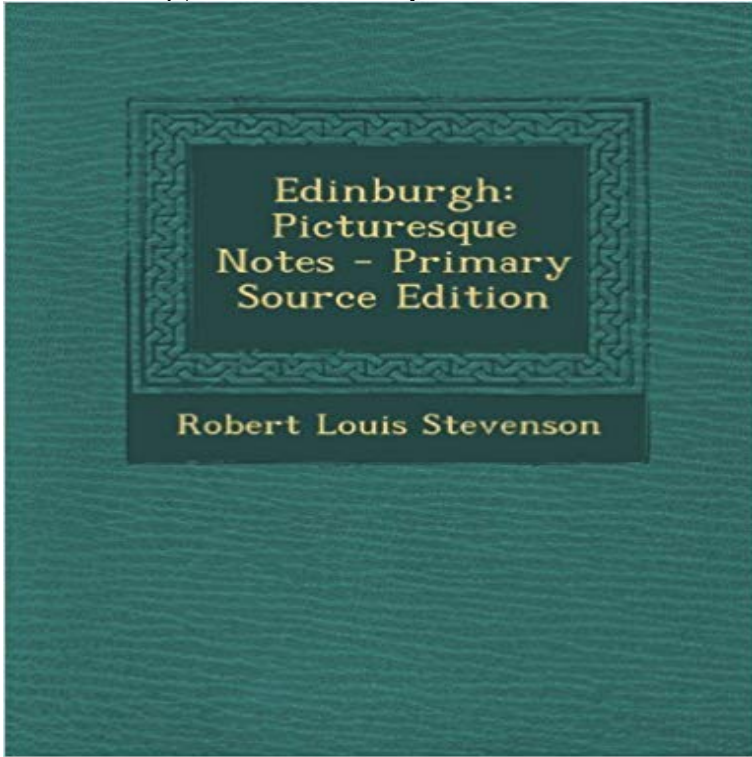


# Edinburgh: Picturesque Notes
