I observed that about the time I came to the boatside the fire was pretty well out, and the noise abated; but in about half an hour after I got on board I heard a volley of our mens fire-arms, and saw a great smoke; this, as I understood afterwards, was our men falling upon the forty men, who, as I said, stood at the few houses on the way; of whom they killed sixteen or seventeen, and set all those houses on fire, but did not meddle with the women or children. By the time the men got to the shore again with VOL. II. S the pinnace our men began to appear; they came dropping in some and some, not in two bodies, and in form, as they went but all in heaps, straggling here and there in such a manner that a small force of resolute men might have cut. them all off.
