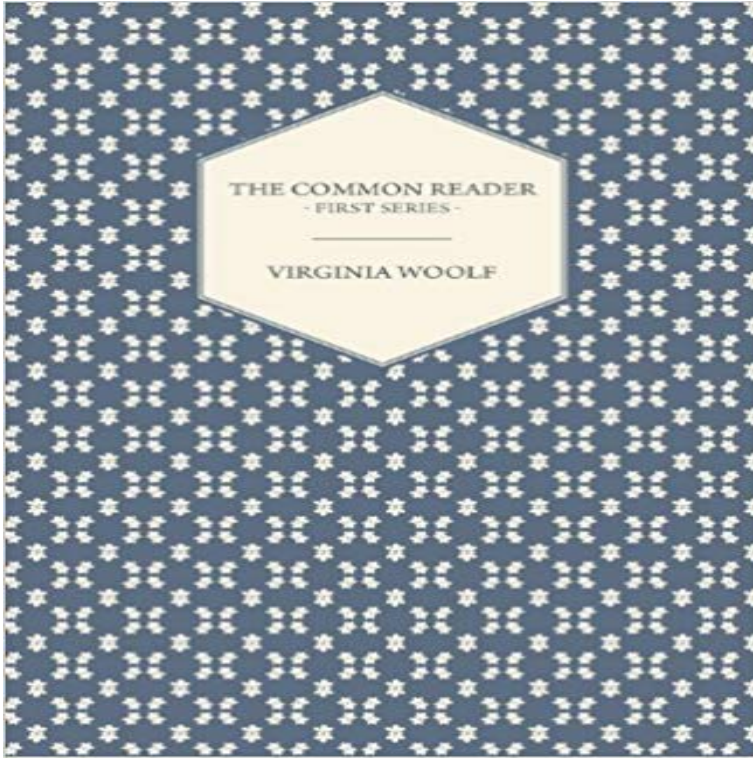


The Common Reader - First Series
