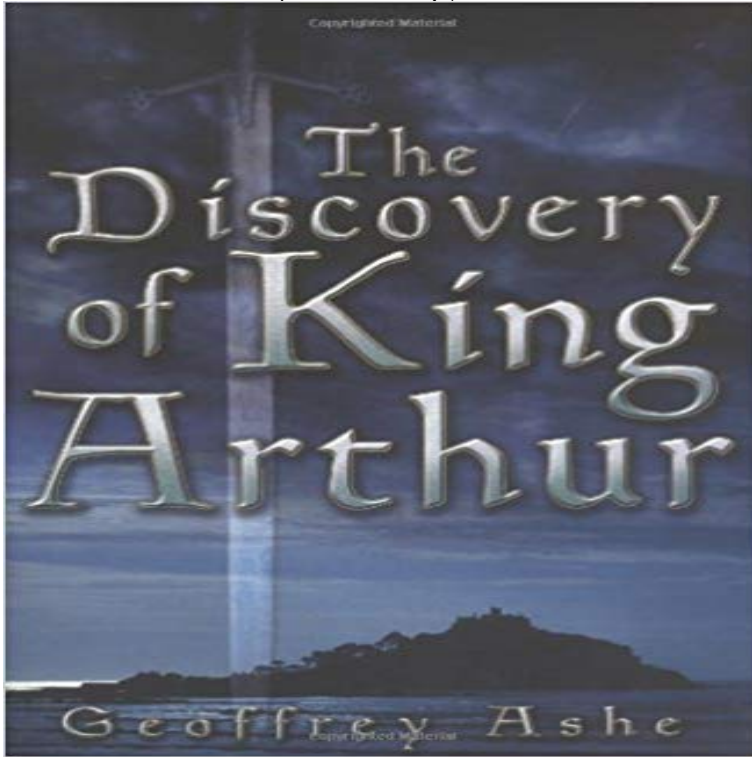


The Discovery of King Arthur

He provides a useful synopsis of Geoffrey of Monmouth's 12th-century *History of the Kings of Britain* as it relates to the Arthur myth, and delves deeply into the world of post-Roman Britain searching for clues and links to the king mentioned therein. Stepping from literary imagination to real history, and presenting fresh interpretations of material, this is a great book and one which takes the Arthur legend seriously.
