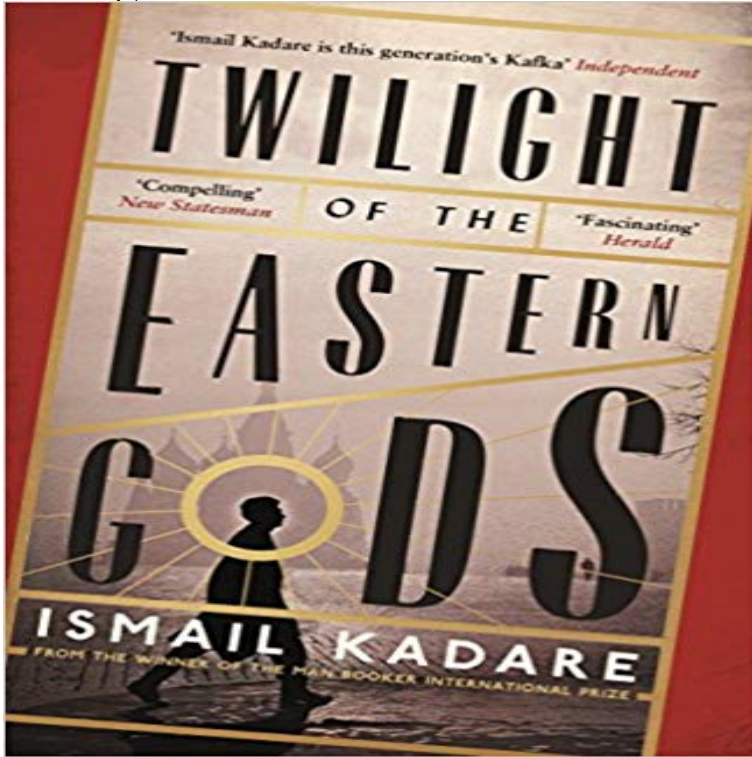


Twilight of the Eastern Gods



1958. In a dorm room in Moscow, a young writer is woken by the sound of angry voices on the radio.
