The Grand Canyon (Hopi: Ongtupqa Yavapai: Wi:ka?i:la, Navajo: Tsekoo Hatsoh, Spanish: Gran Canon) is a steep-sided canyon carved by the Colorado River in Arizona, United States. The Grand Canyon is 277 miles (446 km) long, up to 18 miles (29 km) wide and attains a depth of over a mile (6,093 feet or 1,857 meters).
