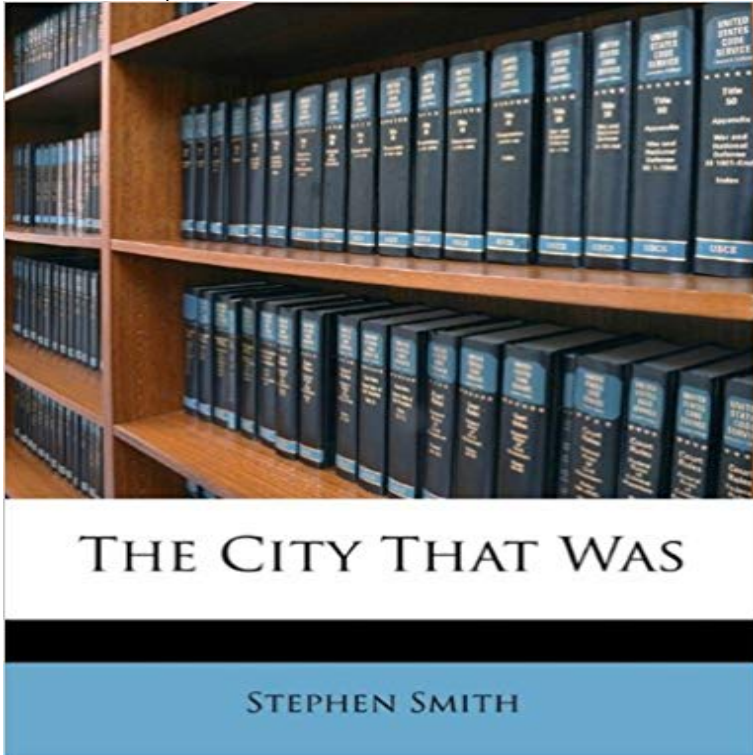


The City That Was
